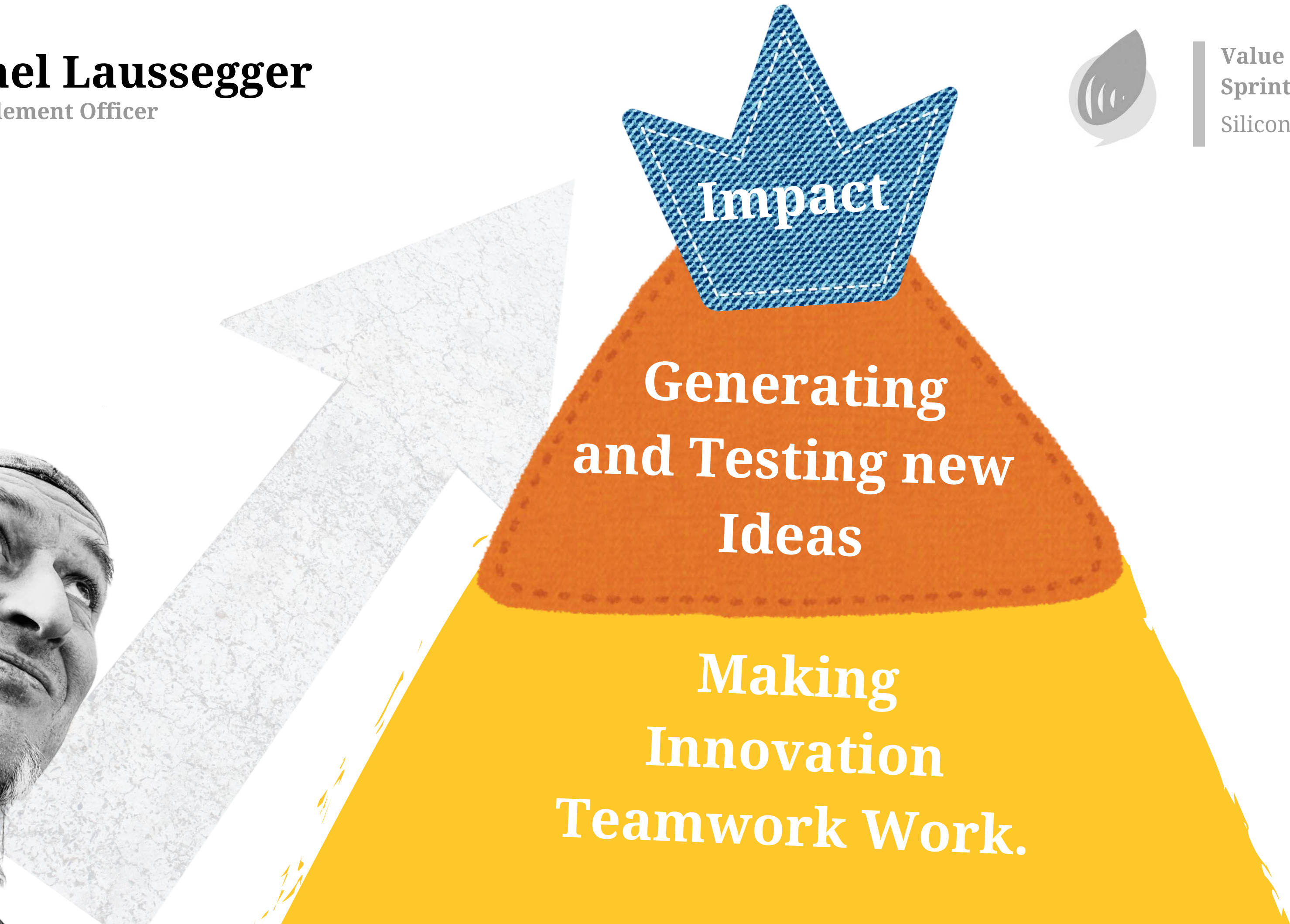

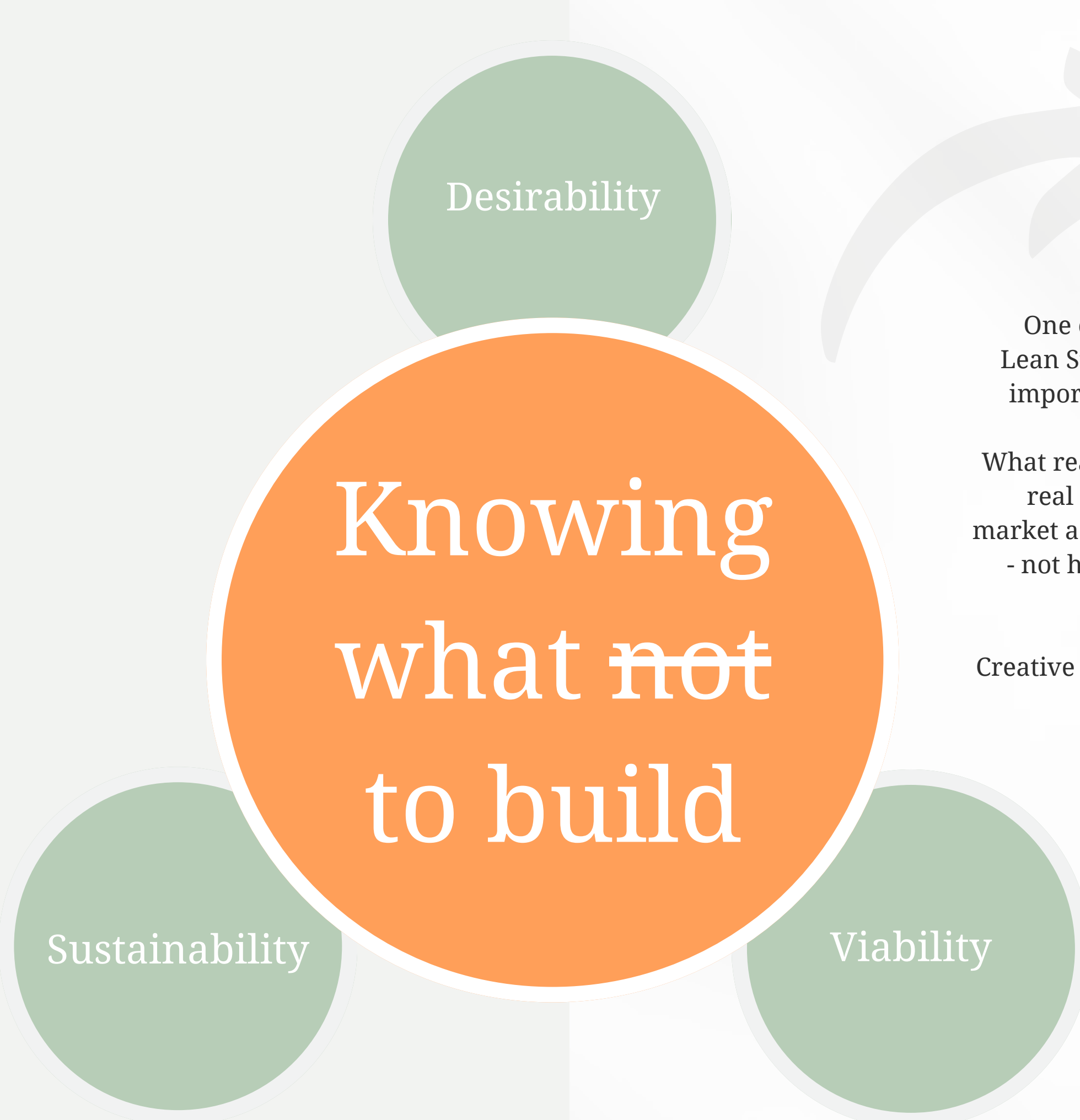

One of the most common mistakes people make with Lean Startup and Design Thinking is believing that it is important to build a first version of a product quickly.

What really matters is a test where real customers make real buying decisions. This is how you prove that the market actually exists. You need prototypes - lots of them - not half-finished products. And you need people who enjoy talking to real customers.

Creative people love to test feasibility. Few fail, however, and testing can be very expensive.

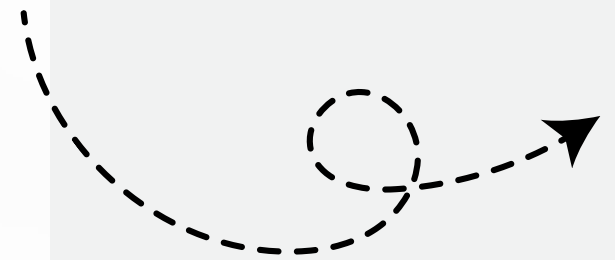
Should we scale it?

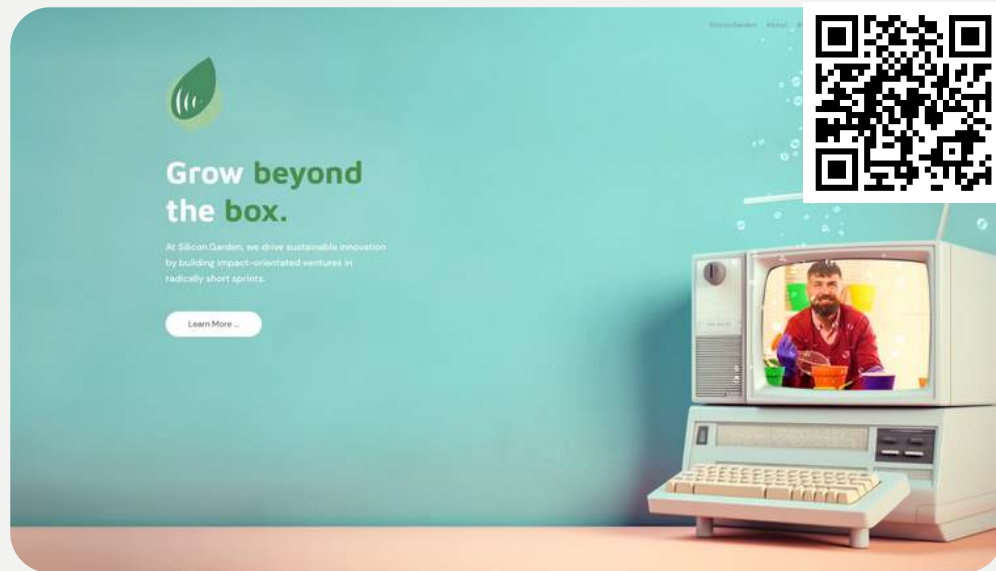

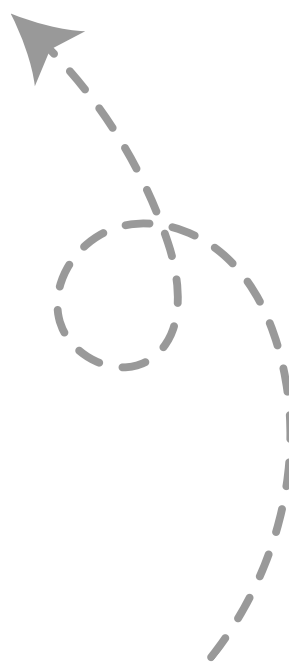

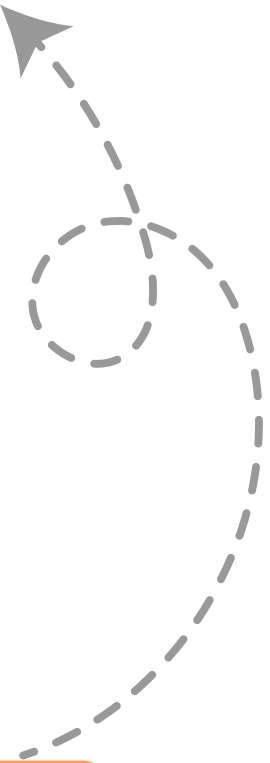
Professional Background

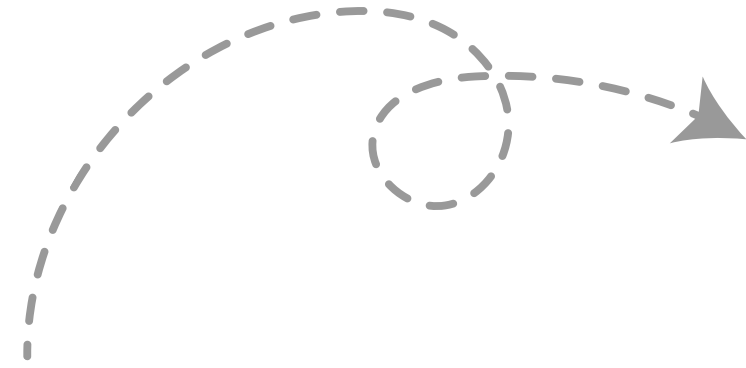
